

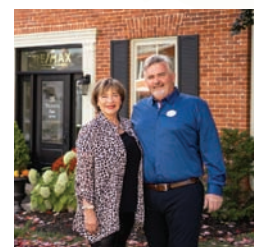

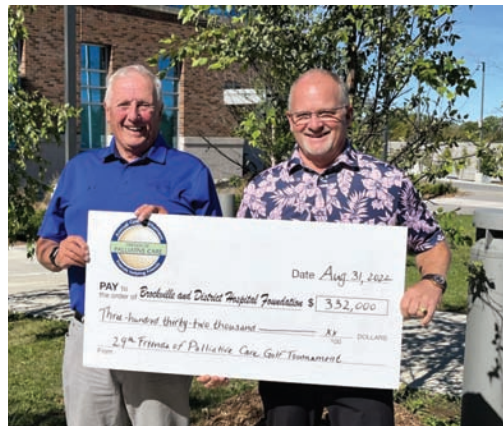
This dedicated committee led by Dave Publow & Jim Cooper, will mark its 30th Anniversary in 2023.

The Carolyn Sifton Foundation generously donated \$1,000,000 towards the new MRI!

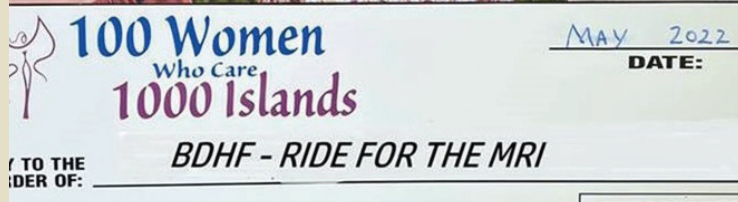

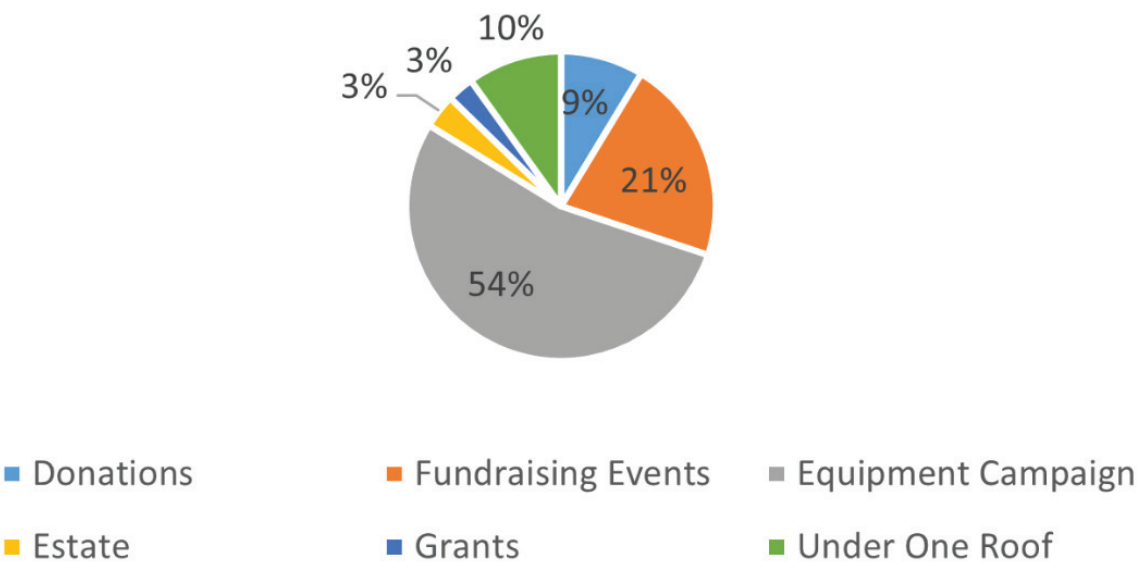
